Call to Order

The regular monthly meeting of the Historic Preservation Commission was called to order on Wednesday, May 1, 2019 at 7:00 PM.

Review and Approval: March 6, 2019 Meeting Summary

Mr. Sherrill moved to approve the meeting summary. Mr. Bensen seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

New Business

Certificate of Appropriateness Application: (HA-997) Calvary Church – 1312 Calvary Road

Applicant: Rev. Argie Araujo

Mr. Gallihue reviewed the application with the commission. The file includes references to windows and doors. Rev. Araujo confirmed that the present request is replacement of ten non-original sanctuary windows. Stained glass windows are not a part of this application. Replacement of the front doors was also referenced in discussion. The applicant clarified doors not a part of the current application.

There was initially some questions from Mr. Coates about the shutters. He had examined the hardware and offered some recommendations for future work. The discussion then focused upon the instant proposal of replacement windows. The replacement windows will be installed into the existing window frames by Andersen Windows. The exact design of the original windows is not known. There was discussion of how the record of historic images does not provide guidance. The replacement windows

are not made of wood, but are a wood-like synthetic material. The window design, *Renewal* by Anderson, will be a full-divided light style, with
