Registration Open for Harford County's Free "Prepare Because You Care" Emergency Preparedness Training Program

Register now for Harford County's free "Prepare Because You Care" emergency preparedness training program developed by the county Department of Emergency Services.


The next four-week session will be held on Wednesday evenings November 7 and 28, and December 5 and 12, 2018. All classes will be held from 7 – 9 p.m. at the Level Volunteer Fire Company, 3633 Level Village Road in Havre de Grace. Participants must be over 18; younger attendees are permitted with written consent from a parent, close relative, or guardian.
