### **Harford County to Honor 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Armistice Day on November 11**

**BEL AIR, Md.**, (Oct. 30, 2018) - At 11 a.m. on Sunday, November 11, Harford County Executive Barry Glassman will lay a wreath at the World War I memorial at Tydings Park in Havre de Grace, joining Mayor Bill Martin and other local officials in remembrance of the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Armistice Day, organized by the Joseph L. Davis American Legion Post 47.

Encouraging all Harford County citizens to join in a moment of silence, County Executive Glassman today issued the following statement:

“From the American Revolution to the present, Harford County citizens have answered the call to defend our nation, and World War I was no exception. In honor of the 47 local citizens who gave their lives, and all World War I veterans who fought for our freedoms, Harford County will join Gov. Hogan, the state, and the nation in the tolling of bells for the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Armistice Day at 11 a.m. on November 11, 2018. At that time, I have asked our volunteer fire companies to sound their sirens and I invite all citizens to take a moment, wherever they may be, to remember the great sacrifice of these true American heroes.”
