Approval of Minutes of the December 15, 2020 Board of Estimates Meeting

The minutes of the December 15, 2020 Board of Estimates Meeting were approved by general consent.

Item No. 01-12-21-01

Mr. Goodwin presented Solicitation No. 19-188; Ma & Pa Connector Trail from Main Street to North Avenue (Segment 2); Competitive Sealed Bid.

Mr. Sandlass made a motion to approve the recommendation, seconded by Mr. Siemek.

Mr. Dave Goodwin from the Department of Parks and Recreation is requesting approval for the installation of a trail pathway and parking lot located at the MA & Pa Trail easements that start at Main Street in Bel Air, MD and terminates at the north side of North Avenue at the parking lot.

The Department of Parks and Recreation recommends award in the amount of \$2,115,555.00 to Allan Myers MD, Inc of Fallston, MD in accordance with Section 41-25 of the Harford County Code.

This motion was unanimously approved.

Item No. 01-12-21-02

Ms. Wright presented Solicitation No. 19-257; Correctional Officer Garments and Gear; Change Order #1.

Mr. Sandlass made a motion to approve the recommendation, seconded by Mr. Siemek.

Ms. Jessica Wright from the Harford County Detention Center stated that this proposal is for the purchase of additional correctional uniforms, accessories and protective vests.

The Harford County Detention Center requests approval for Change Order #1 in the amount not to exceed \$36,000.00 per year, increasing the contract not to exceed amount to \$60,000.00 per year to Municipal Emergency Services, Inc. of Lanham, MD in accordance with Section 41-25 of the Harford County Code.

This motion was unanimously approved.

Item No. 01-12-21-03

Mr. Coates presented Solicitation No. 11-093; Integrated Public Safety Information Systems; Change #5.

Mr. Sandlass made a motion to approve the recommendation, seconded by Mr. Siemek.

Mr. Ross Coates from the Department of Emergency Services stated that this proposal is for software maintenance for the County's Public Safety Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) system.

The Department of Emergency Services requests approval for Change Order #5 in the amount not to exceed \$78,462.14 per year, increasing the contract not to exceed amount to \$317,742.00 per year to Colossus, Inc. d/b/a InterAct Public Safety of Winston-Salem, NC accordance with Section 41-25 of the Harford County Code.

This motion was unanimously approved.

Item No. 01-12-21-04

Mr. Patrick presented Solicitation No. 21-207; John Deere Backhoe Loaders; Piggyback- Sourcewell #032119-JDC.

Mr. Sandlass made a motion to approve the recommendation, seconded by Mr. Siemek.

Mr. Warren Patrick from the Department of Procurement, Fleet Management, stated that this proposal is for the purchase of one (1) 2021 John Deere 310 SL Backhoe Loader and one (1) 2021 John Deere 410L Backhoe Loader for the Department of Public Works- Water and Sewer.

The Department of Procurement recommends award in the amount of \$171,167.02 to JESCO Inc., of South Plainfield, NJ in accordance with Section 41-25 of the Harford County Code.

This motion was unanimously approved.

Item No. 01-12-21-05

Mr. Maley presented Solicitation No. 17-028; Low Voltage Electrical Work; Change Order.

Mr. Sandlass made a motion to approve the recommendation, seconded by Mr. Siemek.

Mr. Ed Maley from the Department of Public Works stated that this proposal is for low voltage electrical work for fire alarms, security systems, A/V systems and IT systems for Harford County locations.

The Department of Public Works requests approval for a Change Order in the amount not to exceed \$200,000.00 per year, increasing the contract total not to exceed \$500,000.00 per year to Harford County Security Systems, Inc. of Bel Air, MD, Vision Technologies, Inc. of Glen Burnie, MD, Skyline Technology Solutions, LLC of Glen Burnie, MD and The Tel-Net Group, Inc. of Baltimore, MD in accordance with Section 41-25 of the Harford County Code.

This motion was unanimously approved.
