Harford County Earns Statewide Paving Award for Road Work in Joppatowne

Bel Air, Md. (April 1, 2024) – The Harford County Department of Public Works has earned the 2023 Excellence in Paving Award from the Maryland Asphalt Association and Maryland State Highway Administration. The team was recognized for their work to repair and resurface 21 streets in Joppatowne’s Rumsey Island community.

The team of judges looked for workmanship, smoothness, joints, texture, and tie-ins with other pavements in determining the winning projects.

Harford’s award in the County Subdivision Resurfacing category was presented during the Maryland Asphalt Association’s 60th Annual Paving Conference in Baltimore in March.
