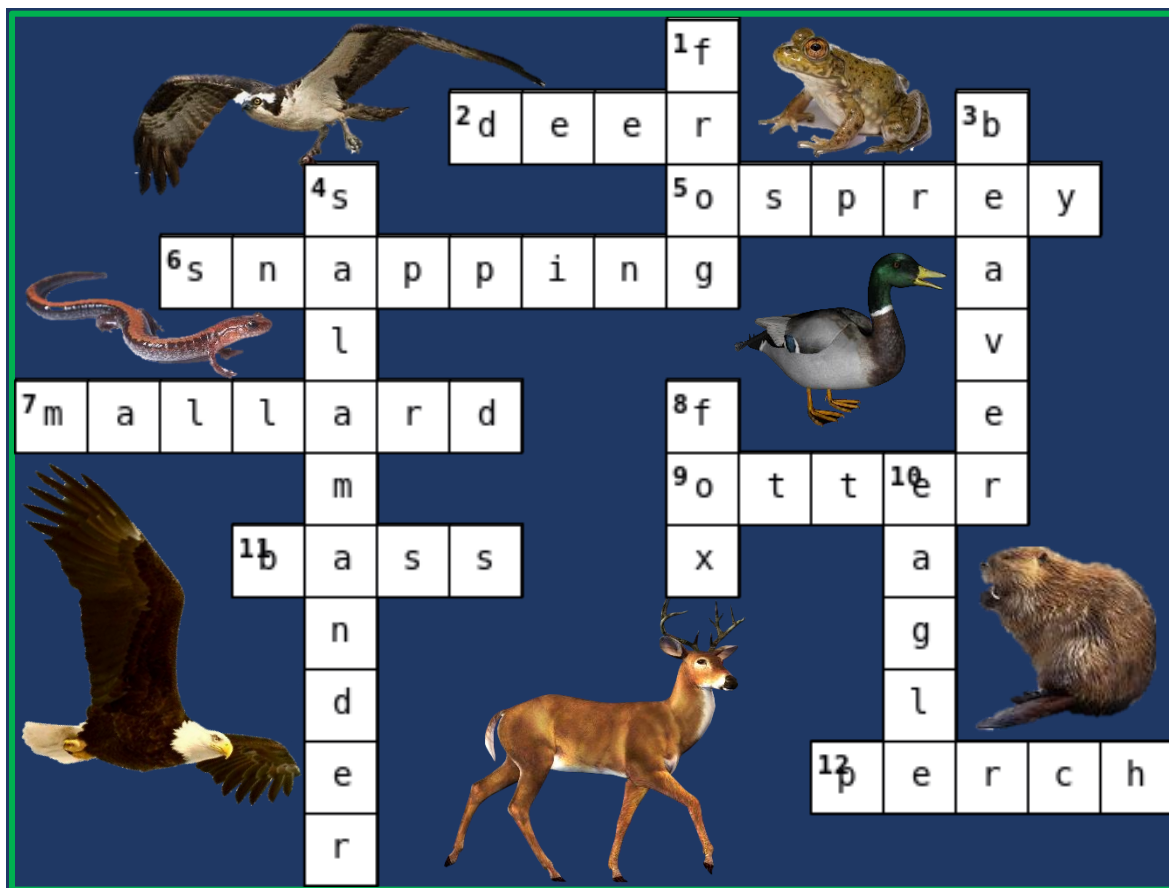


## Harford County Parks and Recreation Weekly Crossword Puzzle Animals Found at Leight Park and Otter Point Creek
