


## Free recycling for live Christmas trees - New drop-off location in Joppa

Recycle your live Christmas tree for free at any of these Harford County locations: 3135 Scarboro Road in Street, from 7 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday through Saturday; Tollgate drop off site at 703 N. Tollgate Road in Bel Air on Saturdays only from 7 a.m. to 3 p.m., and new this year, 808 Philadelphia Road, in Joppa, Saturdays in January only from 7 a.m. to 3 p.m. Please remove all lights, decorations, and tinsel before dropping off. Residents only please, no commercial. Christmas lights and other electronics, clothing, textiles, and more can also be recycled for free at the Harford Waste Disposal Center. 
## State of the County Address January 9


## What you need to know about the county budget

## Just in case ... Harford's Snowplow Tracker

During major snowstorms, you can track the location of county snowplows with our Harford County Snowplow Tracker app. Activated when snow reaches six inches or more, the tracker shows the location of our GPS-equipped plows on county roads using an online map updated every 15 minutes.
